# The goal of the conference

The goal of the conference is to facilitate the exchange of current research ideas and to contribute to mutual communications and possible collaborations for ring and module theory in China-Japan-Korea. Ring and module theorists of other countries are also very much welcomed to the conference.

# Registration

(1) Must register in advance: All participants should be registered by March 25, 2011,

(2) Registration fee: 165,000 Korean Won (about 150 US dollars) for each participant;

110,000 Korean Won (about 100 US dollars) for each accompanying person.

Registration fee should be paid upon arrival. All participants are expected to arrive

on June 27 (Mon.) and depart on July 2 (Sat.), 2011.

The registration fee includes soft drinks, banquet, local sightseeing during the

conference, but does not include meals and the accommodation fee.

## **Abstracts**

Each participant must submit a one page abstract of contributed presentations. It will be printed in a booklet which will be distributed to all participants. Abstracts should be prepared using a LaTeX style file. Abstracts (including titles and affiliations) should be submitted on line through the website.

# **Proceedings**

The proceedings of the conference will be published if a sufficient number of manuscripts are submitted on time. All papers for the proceedings will be referred to achieve a high scientific level.
